

Meghan Markle named 'most attractive' female royal



It's been revealed that Meghan Markle is the most attractive female royal, according to science!

According to a Harley Steret doctor, Meghan came the closest to scoring 100 per cent based to the 'golden ratio'.

This ratio is said to reveal 'perfect' physical beauty, by taking into account face shape and position of facial features.



Harley Street surgeon, Dr Julian De Silva, mapped the 36-year-old's face and compared it to <u>Kate Middleton</u>, Zara Phillips, Princess Beatrice and Princess Eugenie.

With Kate coming second, followed by Zara, and Beatrice and Eugenie taking fourth and fifth place.

Dr De Silva explained to Mail Online that Meghan had an almost perfect nose and that her eye position is 'exactly right'. This meant that Meghan scored a 87.4 score overall – with her nose getting a score of 98.5 per cent!

While Kate came in closely behind the bride-to-be, scoring 86.8 per cent.

The Golden Ratio was a mathematical equation devised by the Ancient Greeks in an attempt to measure beauty.

The ratio can be applied to anything and was used by Leonardo Da Vinci for the perfect human male body in his celebrated Vitruvian Man.

The closer the ratios of a face or body are to the number 1.618, the more beautiful the person is said to be.

Zara Phillips come in at 81.6 per cent, with Princess Beatrice scoring 80.7 per cent and her sister Eugenie getting 79.3 per cent.

According to Dr De Silva, Meghan has 'beautiful' facial symmetry, while Kate has a high score due to the space between her eyes and the position of her nose and lips.
