At this age you really start to look like your mother



We have all heard that sooner or later we will look like our <u>parents</u> - but when? Research by Dr. Julian De Silva, *Harley Street* surgeon, suggests that in the early years after having a child, <u>women</u> start to look more like their mother.

Pregnancy

In the UK, the average age of a woman giving birth to her first child is 30 years old. The women who participated in the study indicated that they had stopped rebelling against their mother and became more like them in their earlier years after having a child.

Outcome

The survey found that 52% of the participants started to behave like their mother when they were between 30 and 35 years old, 26% believe it happened between 35 and 40 years old, and 10% claim that it was only between 40 and 50 years. So wait and see!
